Ironstone Cottage

The classic country cottage, reimagined for contemporary sensibilities.

Fringed with climbing greenery and blooming flowers, Ironstone Cottage is an idyllic picture of English countryside living.

Behind its traditional ironstone façade, heritage details are met with a creative approach to pattern and colour: exposed timber beams and open fireplaces sit alongside striped upholstery, botanical wallpapers and refined furnishings. An oak-framed garden room draws the outdoors into everyday life, while three individually styled bedrooms offer restful retreats upstairs. Beyond, a swimming pool, children's play area and secluded shepherd's hut make the most of the home's pastoral setting.

The living spaces

Cottage character comes into focus in the living room, where exposed beams run overhead and delicate wallpaper wraps the walls. A log burner tucked into an oversized brick and stone inglenook fireplace creates a cosy focal point; it's a space tailor-made for slow mornings and fireside evenings.

A separate television room offers another place to switch off, this time in a soft sage-green palette. A traditional fireplace, striped sofa and tactile furnishings keep things feeling relaxed – ideal for quieter evenings after days spent exploring the nearby villages.











Kitchen & dining

Warm and welcoming, the kitchen balances rustic details with a pared-back palette. An exposed red-brick wall forms a backdrop to the premium Lacanche range cooker, while marble worktops, cream cabinetry and a wood-topped island ensure a streamlined culinary set-up.

Painted doors open into the oak-framed conservatory – the social heart of the home. Beneath a large skylight, the marble-topped dining table is positioned for long breakfasts and convivial dinners, while relaxed seating offers a spot to linger afterwards. Full-height glazing and doors frame views of the garden, creating a natural transition outdoors in warmer weather.





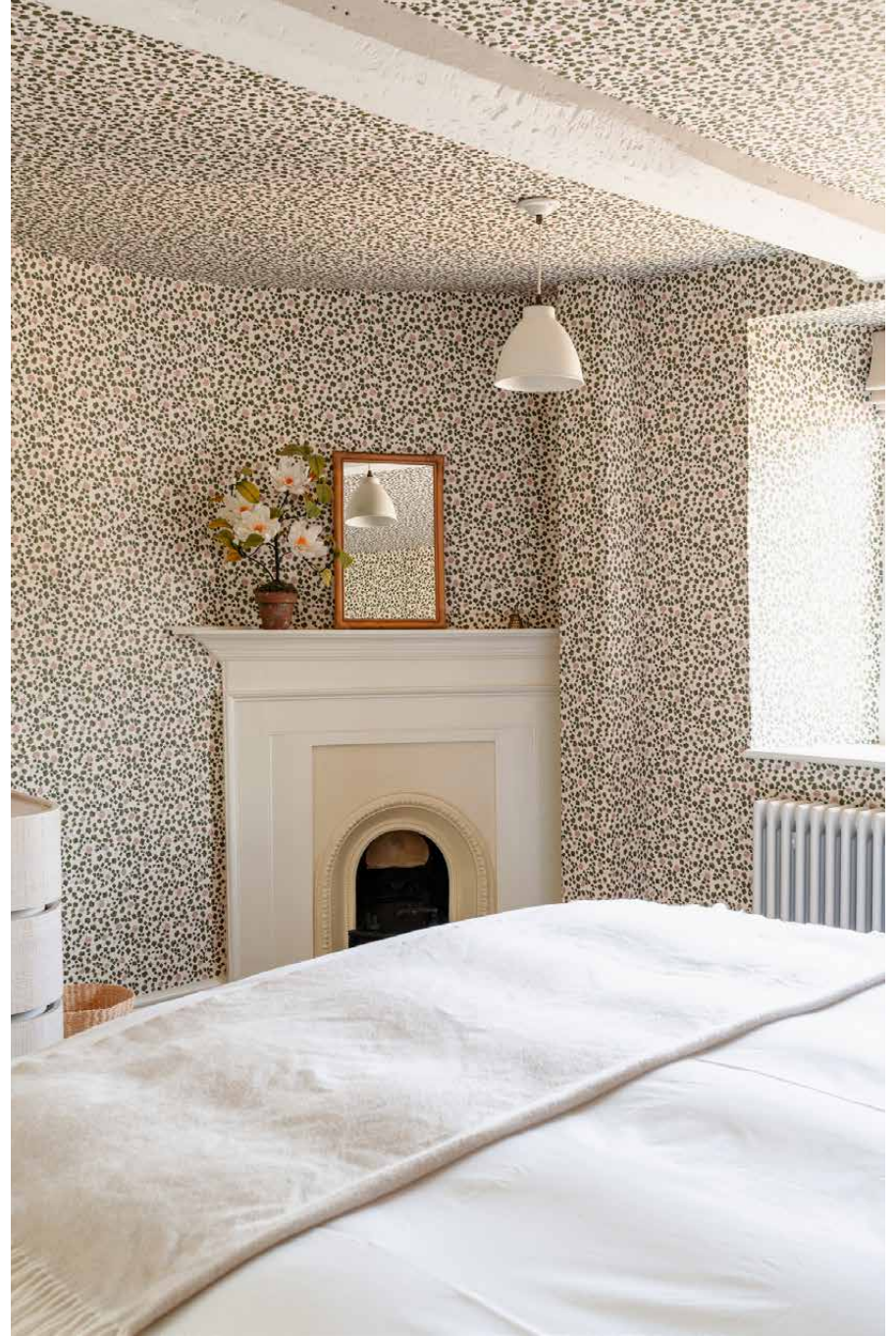




Bedrooms & bathrooms

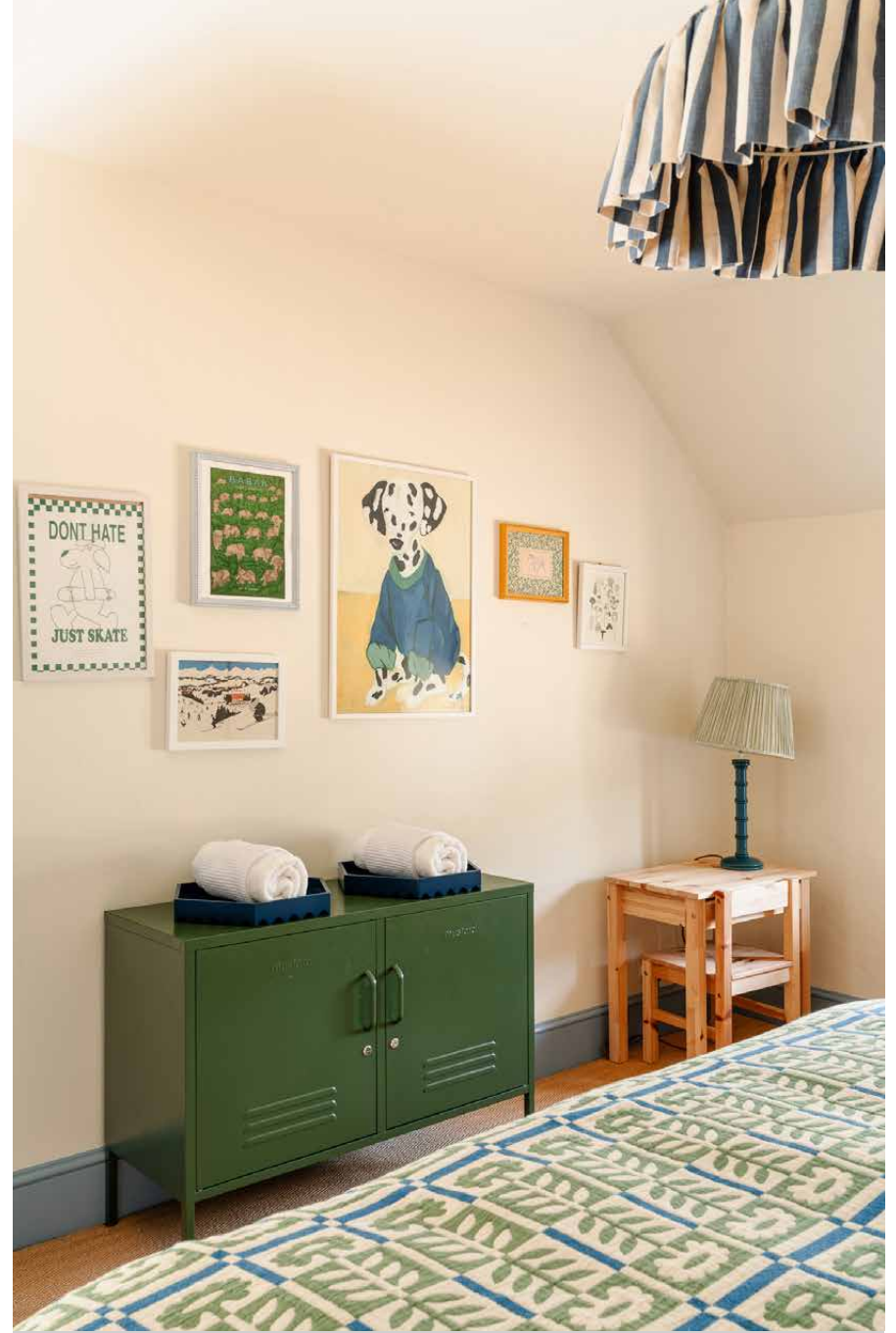
A winding staircase leads to three individually crafted bedrooms. Charming floral motifs envelop walls and ceilings, while upholstered headboards, painted joinery and bold artwork bring considered flair. Tucked into the eaves on the top floor, the third bedroom has a particularly cocooning feel. Gnarled timber beams trace the vaulted ceiling, while a curtain pulls back to reveal a striking copper bathtub.

In one of the other bathrooms, deep-green panelling meets a blue freestanding bathtub and patterned wallpaper; in the third, marble and glass bring a modern touch.







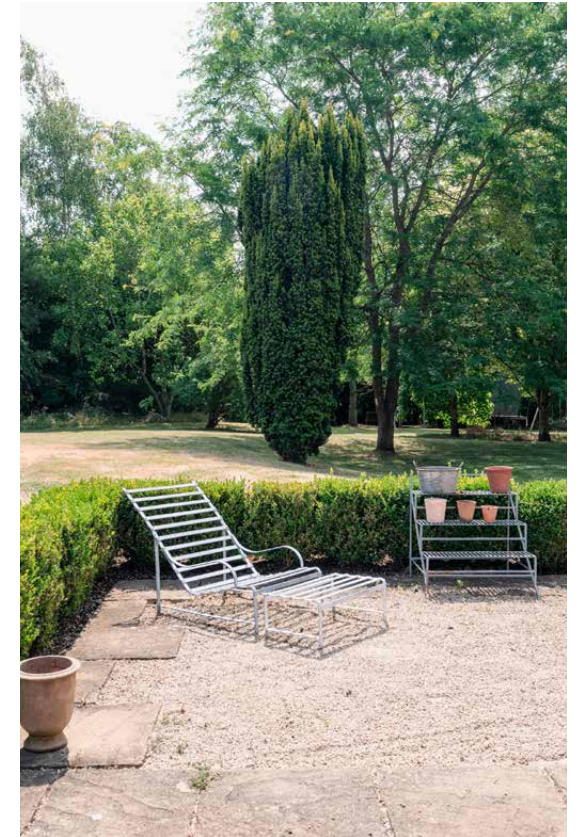




Outside spaces

Summer unfolds at an easy pace here. Directly outside the house, a dining terrace is surrounded by mature planting—a secluded setting for leisurely lunches, weekend barbecues and evening drinks. Beyond, lawns and trees create plenty of room for younger guests to explore, with dedicated playground equipment too.

A walled section of the grounds conceals the swimming pool, while a shepherd's hut sits quietly among the trees. Clad in dark-green corrugated metal, it blends into its leafy surroundings; inside, whitewashed panelling, a wood burner and built-in bed create a cosy additional retreat with a sense of privacy from the main house.









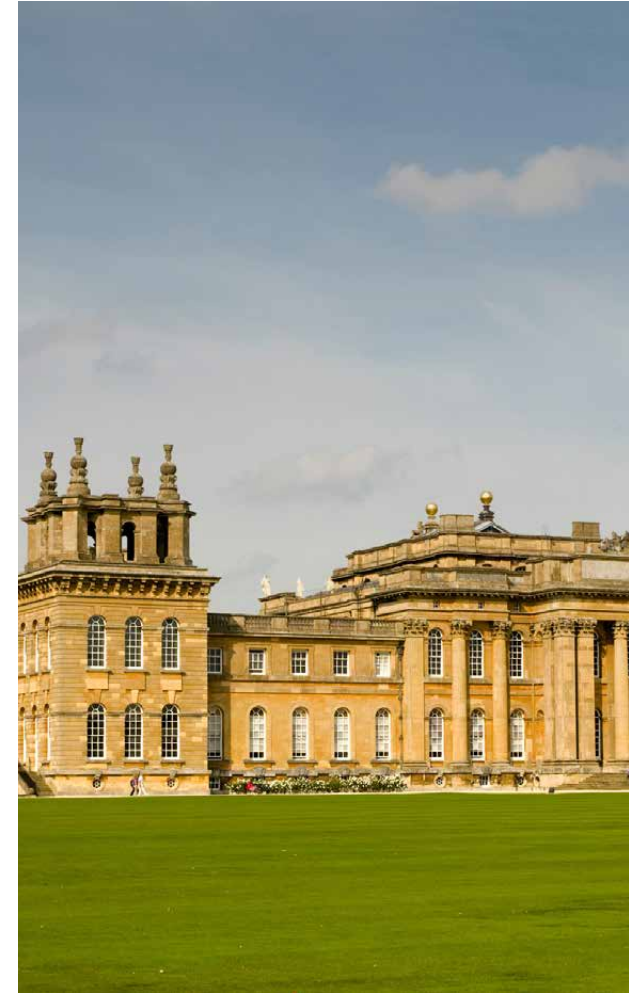




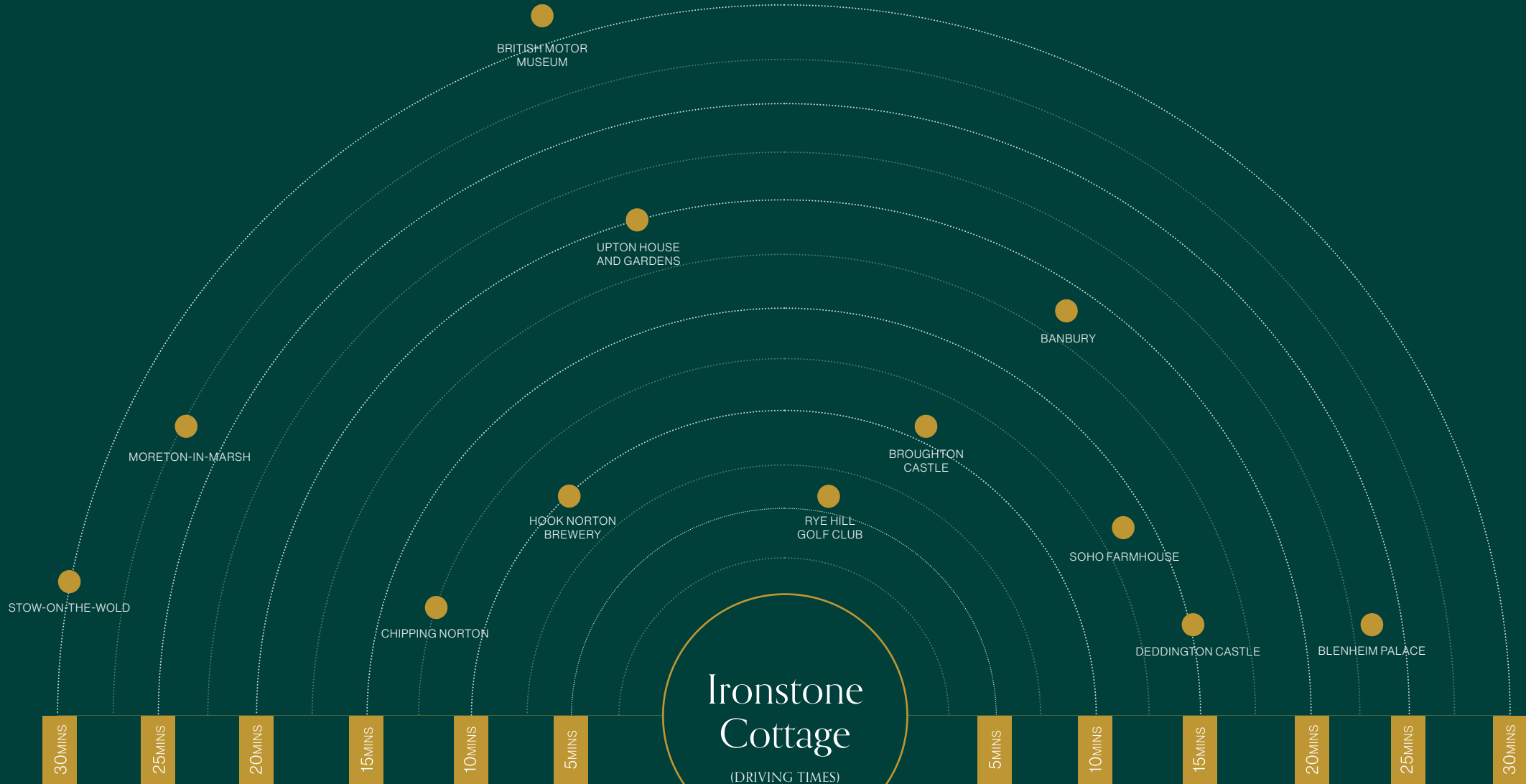
The surroundings

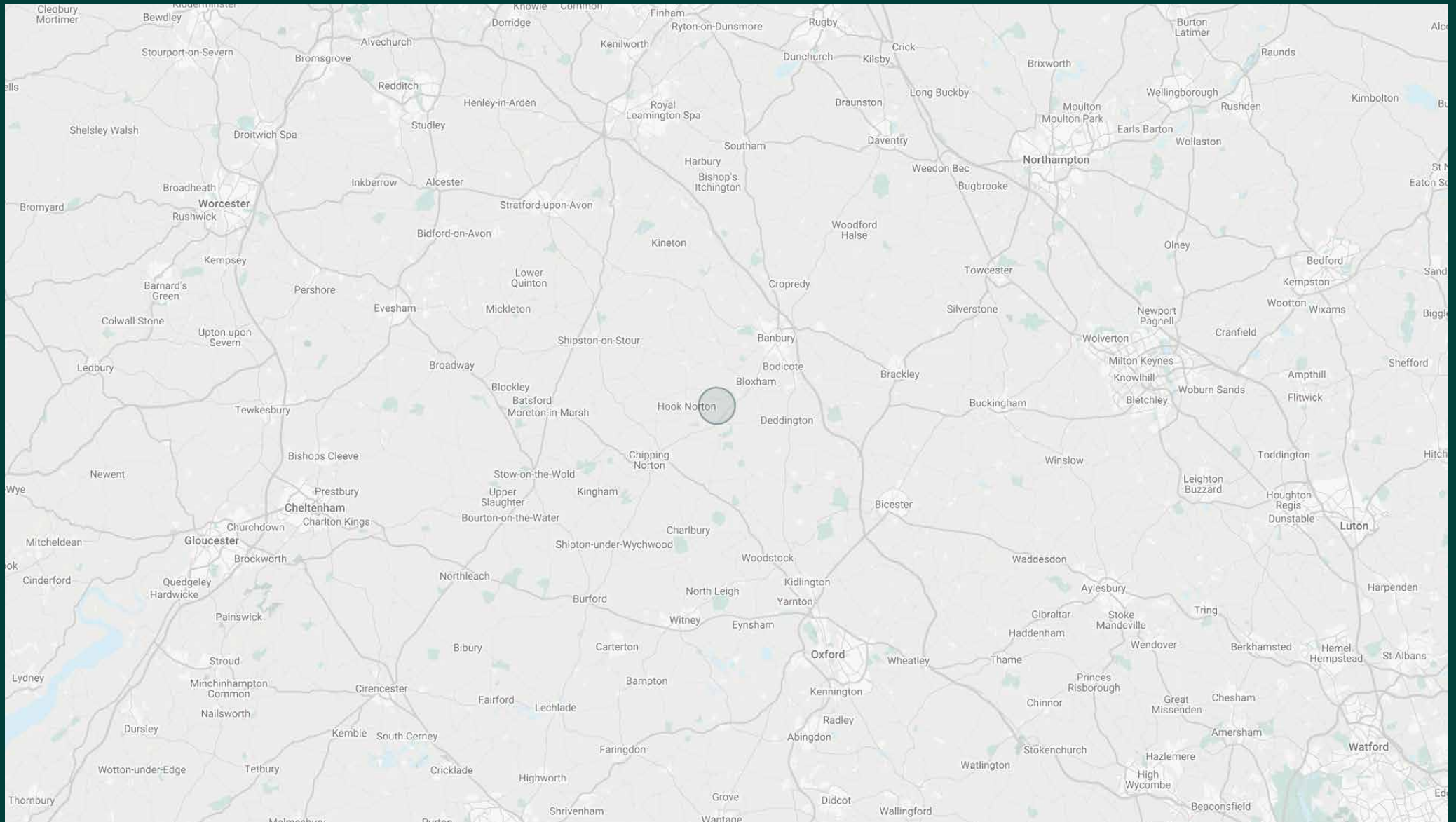
Set beside the River Swere on the Oxfordshire edge of the Cotswolds, Wigginton is a quintessential English village surrounded by rolling countryside. At its heart, the Church of St Giles traces its origins back to the 13th century, while footpaths through the surrounding landscape make it easy to embrace the slower pace of country life.

Every July, the family-friendly Cornbury Music Festival brings musicians from around the world to a countryside park. Soho Farmhouse is a short drive away, complete with its coveted spa and gym. For organic farm produce, Daylesford is your go-to, with an on-site restaurant and wellness centre. It's ten minutes to reach the market town of Chipping Norton features plenty of antiques shops and artisanal cafes, as well as the beloved Theatre – a must-visit for Christmas pantomimes, followed by food at The Boxing Hare. Take a drive to the private country club of Estelle Manor, or further on to Woodstock and the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Blenheim Palace; after a long walk through the grounds, head to The Nest for Michelin-standard food.
