In the picturesque market town of Stow-on-the-Wold, this six-bedroom Cotswolds home is designed for stylish living and effortless hosting.

Serenity is the order of the day in this recently-refurbished country house, with interior design by an acclaimed London studio. Curated and deeply comfortable, Shipton House carries the elegance of a city home softened by pastoral charm.

Beyond its pale stone façade await considered social spaces and bespoke bedroom suites made for gathering in style. Outside, you're on the doorstep to one of the Cotswold's most charming hilltop market towns, Stow-on-the-Wold.





Living spaces

Head into the first reception room – a formal setting that exudes warmth, backdropped by soothing sage walls, an inviting fireplace and an assortment of sink-in seating. For more cosy conversation spots, there's a snug set against stylish shiplap walls. Elsewhere, the garden room introduces a playful counterpoint, its bold artwork and statement orange sofa positioned perfectly for cinematic lounging. Here, bi-folding doors retract entirely, dissolving the boundary between the indoors and the garden beyond — ideal for streamlined flow during the summer months.





Kitchen & dining

The shaker-style kitchen is an inspired space for culinary creativity. Pale cabinetry – accented with gilded hardware – is softly illuminated by a generous window. A glossy-topped island centres the space, curving round with neatly-crafted wood panelling. Morning conversations naturally gather around the red leather breakfast stools.

Through a pair of archways, the dining room appears as a quiet sanctuary. At its heart, a wooden table provides the stage for everything from intimate family suppers to celebratory feasts. Back in the kitchen, the home bar adopts a richer, evening mood: golden worktops gleam against olive-green cabinetry, inviting nightcaps and leisurely cocktail hours.











Outdoor space

In the private courtyard garden, a manicured lawn intersects with pale stone terraces, forming an effortless backdrop for sun-soaked afternoons. Beyond, a timber-clad dining pavilion offers a rustic setting for alfresco meals.



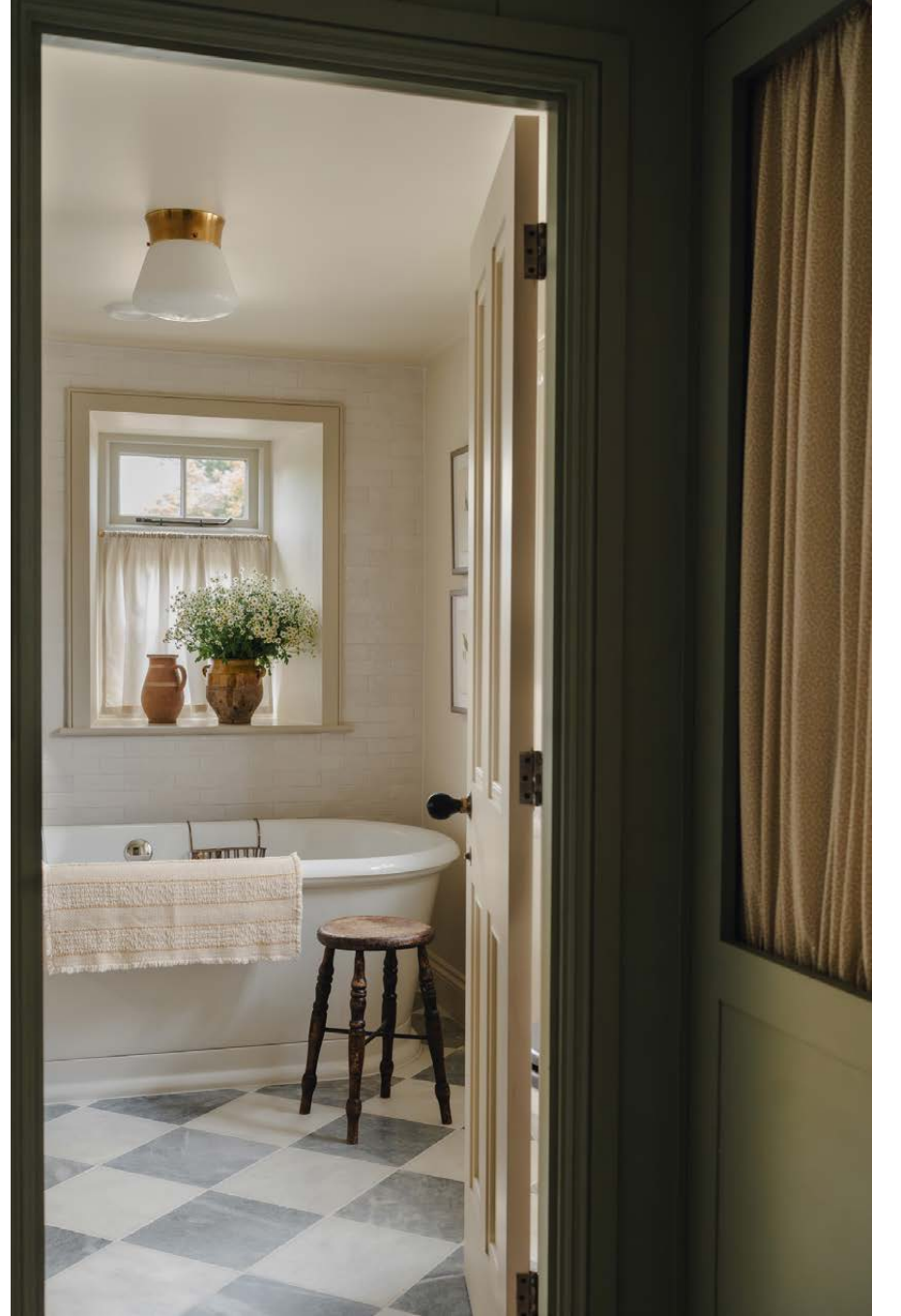


Bedrooms & bathrooms

The individually-designed bedrooms are at once uplifting and tranquil. Expect a considered interplay of pinkish tones, shiplap detailing, patterned textiles and soft natural light. Four bedroom suites occupy the first floor, while the voluminous loft level hosts an additional suite and a further bedroom, with bespoke beds carved into the eaves. Bathrooms echo the home's elevated aesthetic: sleek tiles, sculptural bathtubs and refined fixtures create spaces with spa-like calibre.



















The surroundings

A jewel among the Cotswold towns, Stow-on-the-Wold is the ideal base for unhurried exploration. Wander between its famed antiques stores and inviting tea rooms, before admiring the yew-tree-framed doors of St. Edwards Church – thought to be an inspiration for Tolkien's 'Lord of the Rings'.

A trip to the Cotswolds wouldn't be complete without a visit to Daylesford, just an 8-minute drive away. There's a farm shop stocked with organic produce, a farm-to-fork restaurant and wellness spa by Bamford. Take a gentle stroll through green fields and you're in the village of Lower Oddington, with its famed gastropub The Fox serving outstanding food in a handsome interior setting.

Boutique shopping and art galleries await in nearby Kingham and Chipping Norton, while the Michelin-acclaimed Wild Rabbit showcases modern British cuisine in a historic renovated inn. Affectionately known as Venice of the Cotswolds, Bourton-on-the-Water charms beside the gently flowing River Windrush.

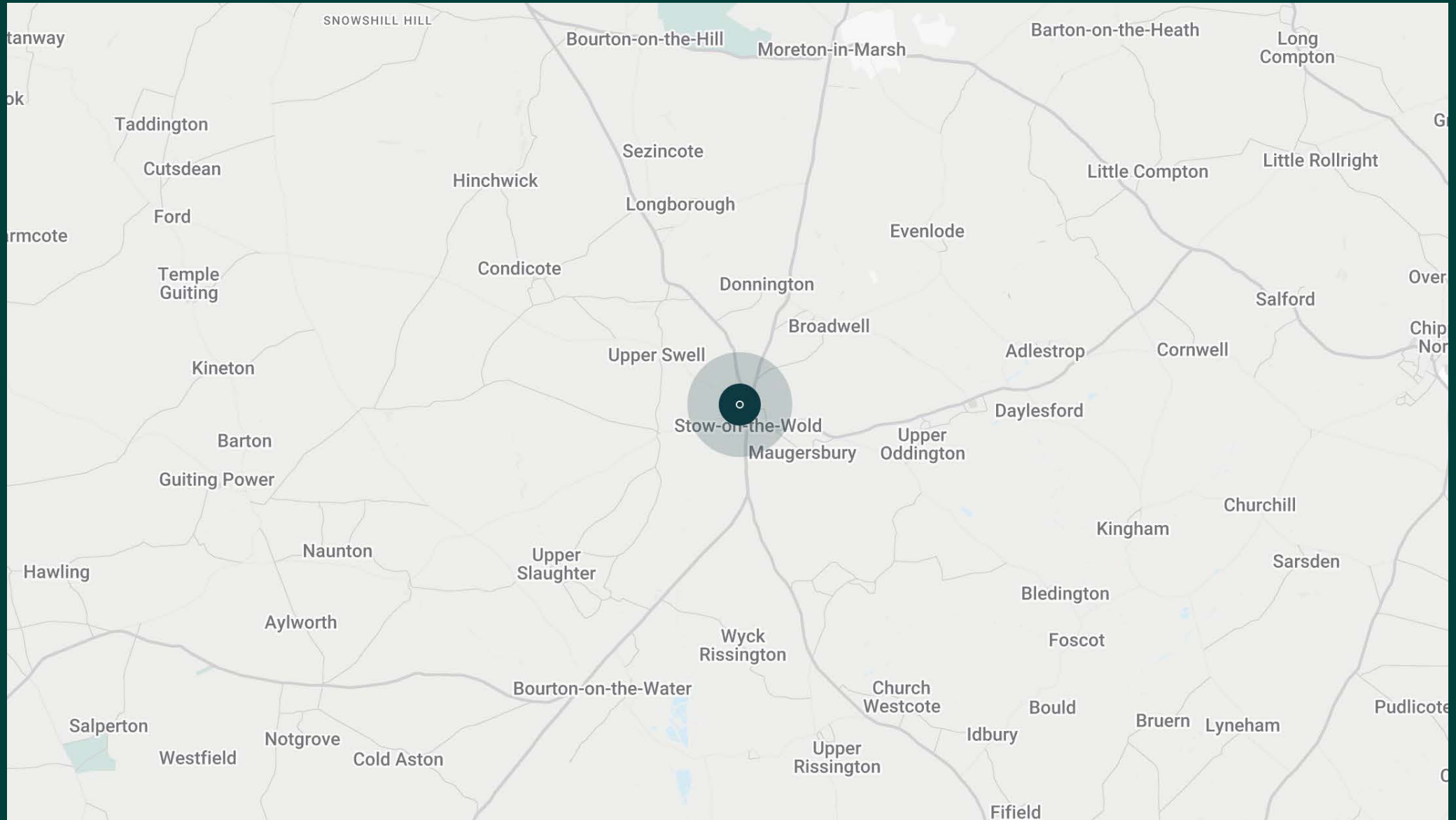
